

Details of the Walk

When: Saturday, October 26, 2013. Registration opens at 8:00am and the walk begins at 9:00am.

Where: Washtenaw Community College (4800 E. Huron River Drive, Ann Arbor, MI) in the Community Park located behind the Business Education Building.

Parking: Please enter off of E. Huron River Drive as the Clark Road entrance will be closed/blocked. Plenty of parking is available onsite in multiple lots around the campus at no cost.

Upon Arrival: Please meet at the Manpower tent. Please do not go to the main ACS/Making Strides Registration tent. The Manpower tent will be staffed with our volunteers for registration, money collection and questions. We encourage everyone to register online prior to the walk; however if you are unable, you MUST check in and register at the Manpower tent upon arrival.

Flagship Speaker: Anne Ramsey will be speaking on behalf of Manpower as a Flagship Sponsor at 8:49am. If you would like to cheer her on, please make your way up to the stage at that time!

Team Photo: Gather near the Manpower tent at 8:15am for more information on photo location. Our photo is scheduled to be taken at promptly 8:30am and all Manpower walkers are expected to be a part of this photo. Please do not be late!

Shirts/Dress: Look for us wearing burgundy shirts with the Manpower logo on the back. If you have not received yours yet, we will have the remaining shirts at the Manpower tent the day of the walk. Check the forecast and dress to stay warm and dry - layers are always a good idea as are hats, gloves/mittens, etc.

Snacks/Drinks: Manpower will have donuts and water available at our tent priot to the walk. The ACS will also be providing snacks and refreshments between laps and following the completion of the walk.

Final Notes: The entire path is paved so you are welcome to bring strollers, wagons, wheelchairs, etc. However, please NO rollerblades, scooters, bikes, etc. ...and please NO pets/dogs.

Making Strides Against Breast Cancer of Ann Arbor Frequently Asked Questions

- Where is the event located?
 - Washtenaw Community College, 4800 E. Huron River Drive, in the Community Park located behind the Business Education Building.
- Where is parking? And do I have to pay for parking?
 - Plenty of parking is available in multiple lots around campus at no cost.
 Please use the Huron River Drive entrance for open lots. The Clark Road entrance will be closed the day of the walk.
- Can I bring my dog?
 - We strongly recommend that you do not bring dogs with you.
- What time does the walk start?
 - Registration opens at 8:00 a.m. The walk is a one-time start at 9:00 a.m. There will be warm up exercises and an opening ceremony starting shortly before 9:00 a.m. We recommend getting there early to park and make your way to the main event area.
- Where do I go once I get to WCC?
 - Please make your way to the registration tent to turn in any donations and to register. If you are already signed up online and do not have any money to turn in, you do not need to visit the registration tent. Feel free to enjoy the pre-walk program and activities.
- Will there be coffee?
 - Coffee will not be provided, however, water and snacks will be available for you and your team members at the finish line after the walk.
- How long is the route?
 - The route is a 5k, with a short cut option. Vehicles will be circulating at all times for those who need a break or cannot finish the entire route.
- Are there other activities happening that day?
 - Yes! There is an activity area for survivors and their family and friends. Please visit the <u>Hope Starts Here Activity Area</u> to check out all that is happening!
- Can I bring a banner or set up a table for my team?
 - You can bring a team banner to carry on the walk route. We ask that you do not stake anything into the ground. Unfortunately, we do not allow tables to be set up except for logistical event needs.
- What should I wear?
 - Dress according to the weather and, of course, LOTS OF PINK!
