## Monroe County Public Transportation Options (for Manpower Candidates and Associates)

*Below are several bus routes/schedules and additional options for finding reliable public transportation. **ALL INFORMATION BELOW IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE** and is provided only as a guide.*

### LAKE ERIE TRANSIT (LET) BUS ROUTES

#### 1. Fixed Routes

LET buses travel along eight (8) distinct routes with stops at many of Monroe's most popular destinations.

**Hours of service:** Monday - Friday, 6:55am - 5:35pm; Saturday 9:35am - 4:15pm.

**Fares:** Exact fare is required (sorry, drivers cannot make change). Please have your change ready when you board the bus and place it in the fare box. Adults = \$1; Elderly (60+ with ID) = 50¢; Handicapped persons (with ID) = 50¢; Transfers = FREE; Jefferson Tripper Service = \$1. Ticket books are available as monthly passes for unlimited rides = \$30 (\$25 for student passes) or books of 40, 50¢ tickets for \$20 at the Lake Erie Transit Transfer Station located at 730 N. Telegraph Road, or by sending a check or money order payable to: LAKE ERIE TRANSIT, 1105 W. Seventh Street, Monroe, Michigan 48161. Riders can now purchase tickets and passes using Visa, Discover, and Master Card by phone.

**Routes:** See below map or use website provided above.

#### 2. Frenchtown Dial-A-Ride

Call 734-242-6766 for reservations at least one (1) hour before you want to be picked up. The bus comes right to the curb in front of your house to pick you up and take you to your destination within the township. You can also transfer to a bus on one of LET's fixed routes at no charge.

**Hours of service:** Monday - Friday, 6:00am - 6:00pm; Saturday 10:00am - 3:30pm.

**Fares:** Same as Fixed Route fares above.

#### 3. Bedford Dial-A-Ride

Call 888-664-5984 for reservations at least one (1) hour before you want to be picked up. The bus comes right to the curb in front of your house to pick you up and take you to your destination within the township. Bedford service also takes passengers to designated stops in Toledo where they can transfer onto the TARTA system. Those stops are: Miracle Mile (by request 7:20am and 5:20pm); and Westerfield Shopping at Franklin Park (10:30am and 2:00pm).

**Hours of service:** Monday - Friday, 7:00am - 5:30pm.

**Fares:** Same as Fixed Route fares above.

#### 4. Essential Transportation Services (ETS) and Americans with Disability Act (ADA) Services

ETS is a door-to-door service for senior citizens and for those with disabilities in the Monroe County area who meet one or more of the following criteria: you are 60 years of age or older; you are wheelchair restricted; you are unable to go up or down a flight of stairs without assistance; you have great difficulty walking without a cane or walker; or you have an emotional impairment recognized by a state or federal agency.

ADA services are provided as an on-call service of LET for people with qualifying disabilities who have an ADA-certified ID. You can call 734-242-6766 anywhere from 24 hours to two (2) weeks in advance and tell them when you need to be at your destination. They will let you know when and where you will be picked up (within ¼ of a mile of any of their fixed routes).
