ANN ARBOR TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY (AATA) BUS ROUTES

1. ExpressRide

Travels from Canton or Chelsea to Ann Arbor, Monday through Friday only. Cost is \$5 for a single ride; \$40 for a ten (10) ride ticket; or \$99 for a Commuter Pass. All prices are subject to change. Please refer to the website for current routes and rates.

2. Route 609: Dexter - University

Travels from Dexter to various locations in Ann Arbor – including U-M Hospitals and Health Centers. Please refer to the website for current routes and rates.

3. Route 4: Washtenaw (Ypsilanti - Ann Arbor)

Travels from Ypsilanti to various locations in Ann Arbor – including U-M Hospitals and Health Centers. Please refer to the website for current routes and rates.

ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS

1. W.A.V.E. (Western Washtenaw Area Value Express)

Call 734-475-9494 or go to <http://ridethewavebus.org> for rates and information. Fares for the W.A.V.E. are \$2 per ride if staying within Dexter, and \$3 per ride if going as far as Chelsea. Prices are subject to change. Please call the number listed above for current information. The W.A.V.E. travels eastbound from Park Street in Chelsea to Ann Arbor. It travels westbound from Jackson Road / Wagner Road in Ann Arbor to Chelsea. There are scheduled pick ups at the same location every two (2) hours.

2. Michigan Ride Share

Email rideshare@semcog.org for information in Livonia, Macomb, Monroe, Oakland, St. Clair, and Wayne Counties. To see if anyone is interested in carpooling in your area, visit <http://mirideshare.org>. To signup, include information about your commute time and location, preferences on gender, smoking vs. non-smoking, etc. and then link up with others coming from your area to carpool. It is a free service and there is even a "Guaranteed Ride Home" program that reimburses the cost of a taxi, rental car, or bus if you are registered with the program and experience unexpected ride loss, overtime, an emergency, etc.

(NOTE: Guaranteed Ride Home can be utilized two (2) times per month, but no more than six (6) times per year and YOU MUST UTILIZE CAR POOLING REGULARLY TO QUALIFY FOR GUARANTEED RIDE HOME AND BE REGISTERED WITH THE PROGRAM SPECIFICALLY).
